### Intro to Golf Program - FUNdamentals

**Intro to Golf Program – FUNdamentals** Our *Intro to Golf* program is the perfect way for kids to get started in the game in a fun, supportive environment. Aimed at new golfers aged 6-12 years old, groups will generally be split based on age leaving a 6-9 year old group and 9-12. This program consists of three 45-minute sessions built around the FUNdamentals of golf and is led by a PGA of Canada Professional. Participants will be introduced to the key skills of golf, including the full swing, chipping, and putting. Instruction will focus on building strong fundamentals such as grip, stance, posture, and alignment. Each session combines simple instruction with creative games, challenges, and teamwork to help kids develop their skills while building a lasting love for the game. Sessions will take place across the club's practice areas, including the putting green, driving range, and Valley Practice Facility. **Program Details:**

- **Cost:** \$60
- **Capacity:** Maximum of 16 participants (first come, first served)
- Additional sessions may be added if demand is high

#### **Session Times (4:30–5:15 PM):**

- Tuesday, May 19
- Tuesday, May 26
- Tuesday, June 9

## **Junior Golf Summer Program**

### **Junior Golf Summer Program**

Our **7-week Junior Golf Program** is designed to help young golfers grow their skills through a combination of **structured instruction and on-course play**. Each session includes a

30-minute group lesson followed by guided play, giving players the chance to apply what they learn in a fun, supportive environment. Golfers are grouped by age to ensure the right pace, yardages, and development focus.

---

#### **Sessions**

Sessions run on Tuesdays in July and August and start time is dependent on age (see below in *Program details*) but must conclude **no later than 5:45 PM** so ladies league play can continue on time.

**Start Date:** July 7th

**Runs:** July 14th, July 21st, July 28th, August 4th, August 11th, August 18th

**End Date:** August 18<sup>th</sup>

**Final Week Wind-Up:** August 18th

- Ages **9–17** will play **9 holes** (no lesson), starting at **1:00 PM** from varying tees dependent on their program
- Followed by a **banquet with prizes and scoring awards**
- Ages **6–9** will play **6 holes** from junior tees, then join the banquet and supper (**Parents will need to be present so kids can be on course for this age group**)

## 🏌️ Program Breakdown by Age Group

### Ages 12–17 (Junior League)

- Start at **2:30 PM** with a 30-minute lesson
- Play **6 holes** after instruction
- Compete from varying yardages (**double par max score**)
- Track scores throughout the program (best **4 of 6 rounds** count toward average)
- Prizes awarded for scoring, skills, development and sportsmanship
- **Spots Available:** 24

A junior league that is designed for any level of golfer.

---

### Ages 9–12 (Junior Links)

- Lesson: **3:30–4:00 PM**, followed by tee times (**we must be off the course by 5:45**)
- Yardage progression for the first 3 weeks: **25 → 50 → 100 yards**
- Advance to junior tees on the 4th week (**100–250 yards**) on Holes 1–6 (**Double Par Max**)
- Focus on learning fundamentals and applying them on the course
- **Spots Available:** 20

This age on the course will have supervision and are able to ask questions, learn course etiquette, how to play with others, while also learning course management in a safe environment.

---

### Ages 6–9 (Mini Wackers)

- Lesson: **4:30–5:00 PM**
- Play Holes **7–9** from 5:00 PM until 5:40 PM
- Yardages: **green-side –150 yards**
- **Guardian participation required** (one guardian at least per group after lesson for on course activity's)
- Focus on fundamentals and fun introduction to the game
- **Spots Available:** 15

After each lesson, a **parent or guardian is required** to accompany their child on the course. Guardians will take their group to an assigned hole and supervise play until 5:40 PM using designated junior yardages.

---

Yardages will be pre-determined each week and structured to progressively challenge players while reinforcing fundamental skills and proper golf etiquette in a fun, supportive environment.


**Guardian involvement is needed** in this age category to ensure the safety of all participants and to help maintain the care for the course.

- Please have your child dress appropriately for the weather and in golf attire and running/ golf shoes. Please no sandals as children will be walking. Hats, Bug Spray, and Sunscreen are highly recommended.

## **Junior Lesson Program: Parent Information**

### Drop off and pick up:

Parents and guardians should drop off and pick up their child in front of the Clubhouse or park in the parking lot. Parents or guardians that wish to stay and watch the juniors are welcome but we ask that you keep your distance. Lessons will start punctually and run for exactly the stated time.

### Care of Equipment:

Instructors will monitor the use of equipment. Juniors are expected to respect and follow the instructions with regards to care and use of the equipment. Items will include but are not limited to: US Kids demo clubs and training aids, demo clubs, and fitting equipment for other lessons.

### Behavior Expectations:

Juniors are expected to conduct themselves in a co-operative, respectful manner while attending lessons at the golf course.

### Inappropriate behavior includes:

- Interfering with the lesson experiences of others.
- Threats, harassment, intimidation, abuse, fighting or other inappropriate behavior.
- The Junior Program has 'zero tolerance' towards any forms of bullying.

### Three Strike Policy:

Strike 1: Verbal warning

Strike 2: Time out

Strike 3: No longer allowed to participate. No reimbursement will be given.

### What to bring:

- Sunscreen
- Hat
- Bug Spray
- Water
- Appropriate golf attire (no sandals please)

### Weather Policy:

If weather is questionable one hour before the start of the lesson, and the instructors deem the proper route of action is to cancel the lesson, an e-mail will be sent out to all parents stating the lesson is cancelled. If the lesson is cancelled it will be rescheduled at the end of the lesson schedule.

### Payment and Cancellation Policy:

All juniors must be paid for prior to the first lesson. Juniors will be able to cancel out of the lesson program 4 days prior to the first lesson without penalty. Juniors cancelling within 4 days will be subject to a charge unless there is someone on the waitlist to fill their spot. Registrants will be notified of any class changes via e-mail.

## Junior Membership

We take pride in our junior members, and being a family orientated golf club. Membership includes the use of the practice green as well as the Pat Vallely practice facility. Juniors have restricted playing times on weekends only. Juniors may book their own tee-times after 2:00 pm on weekends and holidays. Juniors are not permitted to play before 12:00 pm on weekends and holidays, and between 12:00 pm and 2:00 pm they must be accompanied by an adult.

## **Dress Code**

1. **BOYS DRESS CODE** – Appropriate golf attire; shirts, slacks or tailored shorts, manufactured golf shoes with non-metal spikes or flat, soft soled shoes are to be worn on the golf course. Shirts shall be with collars and sleeves. Mock collars and fashion T-shirts are acceptable. Shorts are to be tailored dress shorts that are comparable to those sold in the Pro Shop. Denim, spandex or other types of aerobic clothing are not permitted at any time.
2. **GIRLS DRESS CODE** – Appropriate golf attire; skirts, shirts, blouses, slacks or tailored shorts and manufactured golf shoes with non-metal spikes or flat, soft soled shoes are to be worn on the golf course. Shirts may be collarless with sleeves or sleeveless with collars. Shorts are to be tailored dress shorts that are comparable to those sold in the Pro Shop. Denim, spandex or other types of aerobic clothing are not permitted at any time.
3. **CLUBHOUSE DRESS CODE** – Appropriate golf attire as described above is acceptable in the Clubhouse. Jeans are also acceptable.

## **Conduct and Pace of Play**

All of our junior members are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful way on and off the golf course. This is also the case when our junior members are representing the club at other golf courses. We also ask that all of our junior members adhere to the Pace of Play Policy. In short, all juniors need to keep up to the group in front of them at all times, if they fall behind they must adjust their actions accordingly and catch up. Please note, all juniors are responsible for their guest's behavior and speed of play at all times.
